Currently the Box Factory on Duke Street is the front runner for the new station location. Time is running out!

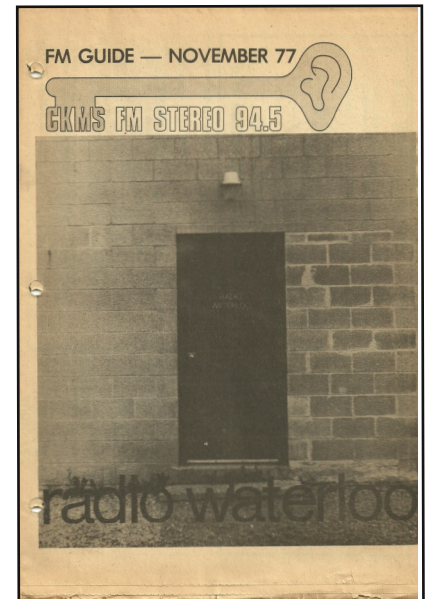
Radio Waterloo has been around since 1964 and officially incorporated as CKMS since 1977. Help fund this culturally historic entity that promotes local arts and culture.
