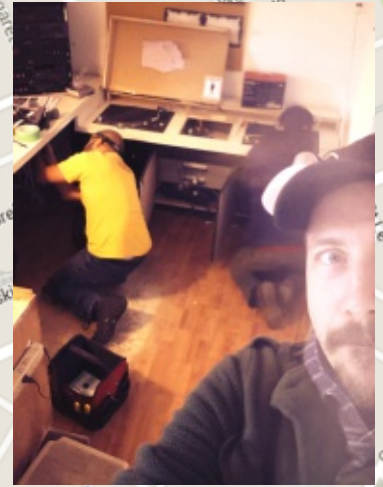

Radio Waterloo has officially moved their station operations from 108 King Street North in Waterloo to the "Box Factory" in Kitchener. This new location breaks the trend of City of Waterloo locations. Upon talking to Board Member Rob Steel he had this to say about the move: "This solidifies the position that Radio Waterloo supports arts and culture throughout the Region of Waterloo and not just the City of Waterloo" This new location is also home to the extremely popular Adventure Rooms and many other local businesses.

There is still a lot of work to be done at the new location. A temporary live station has been set-up where you will still be able to tune in and hear your favourite community members broadcast their unique brand while others continue to improve the new location. It really takes a community to pull together to pull off something of this magnitude.

The Mano A Mano show hosted the first live-to-air at the 108 King Street location interviewing the local band Cyanide Kiss and closed out these station with the last ever live-to-air with an interview with the band from barrie The Alpaca's who rocked out while it was being taken apart.!
